First edition. From 1835 Fries was professor of botany at Uppsala. Fries's foremost accomplishment in botany was in systematics, and today his reputation is based primarily on his mycological work and his ability to describe species. His *Systema Mycologicum* forms the basis for the nomenclature within all groups of fungi except Uredinales, Ustilaginales, and Gasteromycetes. The plates and the lithographed title were printed by A.J. Salmson, Stockholm and Abrah. Lundquist & Cie, Stockholm.

"Grimmia Hedw. is one of the largest moss genera. The taxa are notorious for their morphological variability, causing up to now notable identification problems. As a result of this, herbaria revision showed that up to 40% of the specimens had been misidentified. Lack of overview in the detailed and untransparent taxonomy of Grimmia has continuously led to description of species that had been described earlier, and some commonly occurring, cosmopolitan species were described tens of times, producing a Gordian knot with nearly 1000 names in the Index Muscorum (Van der Wijk et al. 1962). Since 1990, the author has worked on a world-wide revision of the genus, visiting species-rich habitats (Greven 1997), and revising nearly 20.000 herbarium specimens, including hundreds of types. In this paper, 86 taxa are recognized at specific level, in the future this number will grow slightly, however, to all appearance only a few taxa will be added.
